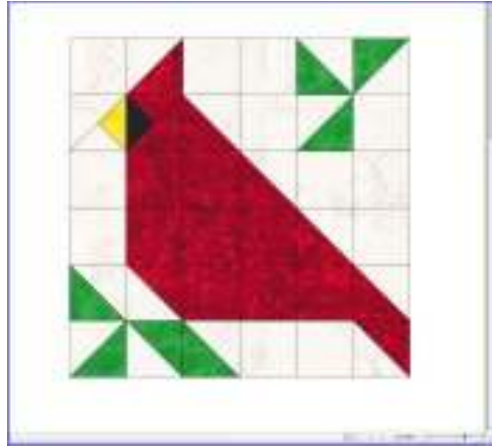
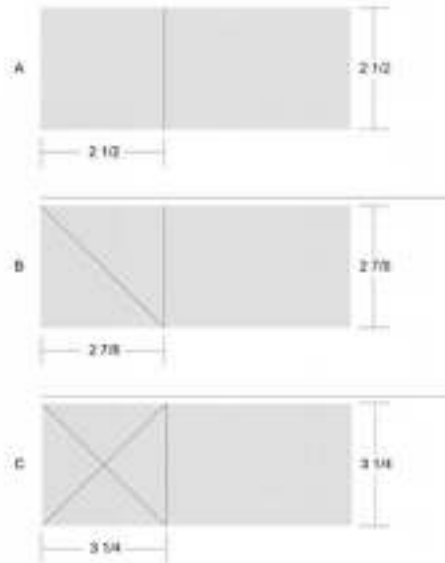


February Block of the Month 2018-Cardinal

Cut Chart : Cut Lines as shown below

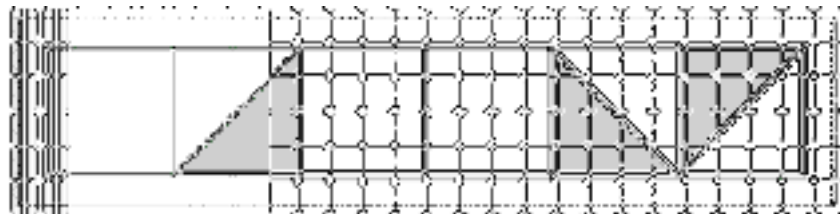


Sewing	White	cut-12	2.5" x 2.5" squares.
		cut-8	2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares
		cut-1	3 1/4" x 3 1/4" square
	Red	cut- 8	2.5" x 2.5" squares.
		cut- 4	2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares
	cut- 1	3 1/4" x 3 1/4" square	
Green	cut- 4	2 7/8" x 2 7/8" squares	
Black	cut- 1	3 1/4" x 3 1/4" square	
Yellow	cut-1	3 1/4" x 3 1/4" square	

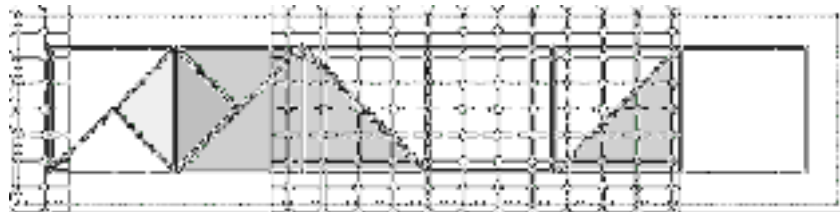
Instructions as follows:

Solid Squares	2-2.5" squares
Half Square Triangles	2-2 7/8" squares
Tri-Squares	2- 3 1/4" squares. Cut x as shown sample C above. 1- 2 .5" square. Cut in half diagonally. Sew RST to the unit sewn above.

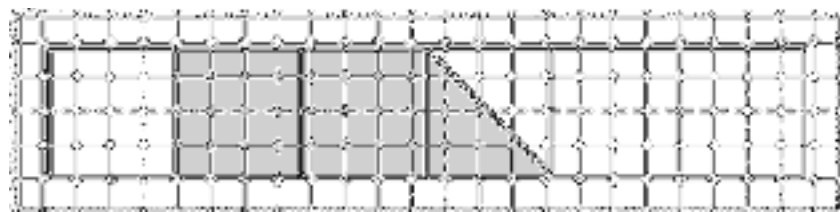

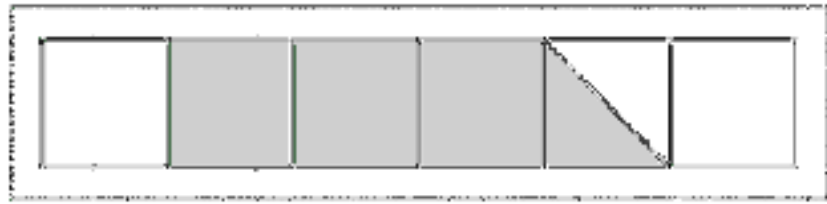
2nd Row Lay Out



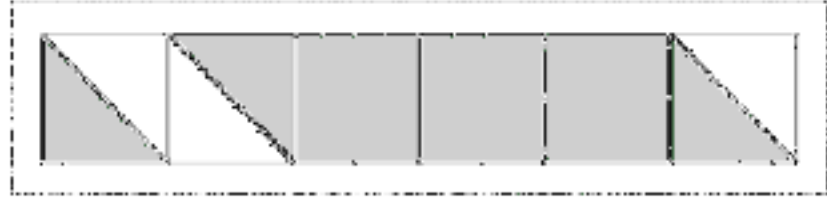

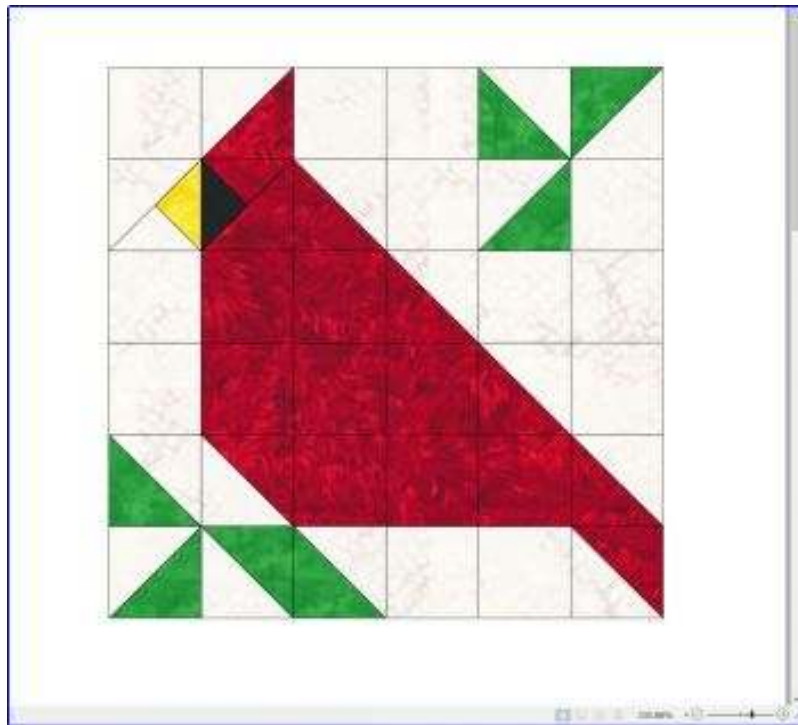
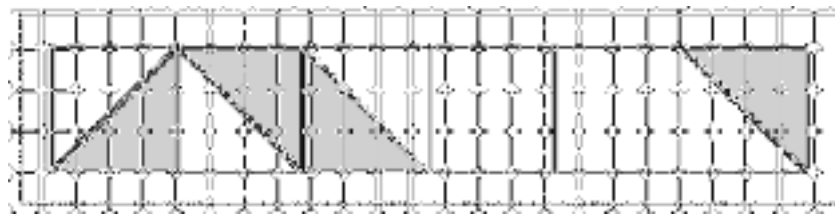
